



## Spray Technician

---

The Spray Technician reports directly to the Golf Course Superintendent and works closely with the Assistant Superintendent to ensure the health and quality of the golf course and practice facilities. The role is critical in maintaining the course's aesthetic appeal and optimal playing conditions by overseeing and executing the application of pesticides, fertilizers, and other treatments according to Washington State regulations and manufacturer's guidelines.

### General Responsibilities & Requirements

---

- Inspect turf, shrubs, lakes, and other areas to determine pesticide and fertilizer needs.
- Responsible for the safe and effective application of products, maintaining accurate records, and ensuring compliance with local environmental regulations.
- Operates with the highest competency, all golf course-related equipment, including specialty machinery needed to apply, renovate and maintain the golf course.
- Play an active role in daily operations of the golf course, assisting with other turf maintenance tasks as needed.
- Comply with all Point Roberts Golf and Country Club policies and procedures as set out by the superintendent and management team.
- Valid Washington State pesticide applicators certificate or capable of attaining within three months of employment

- Knowledge of chemical application equipment
- Ability to work outdoors in various weather conditions
